- Pediatric Health: 2 interns
 - Primary goal is to provide interns with knowledge in evaluation and intervention with medically involved infants, children and adolescents
- Neuropsychology: 2 interns
 - Primary goal is to provide interns with knowledge in evaluation and intervention of the pediatric population with neurocognitive and complex medical conditions impacting the central nervous system

Assessment

- •Developmental, psychological, and/or psycho-educational testing
- •Assess developmental delays, intellectual deficits, learning problems, emotional and behavioral disturbances

Consultation-Liaison

- •Respond to consultations ordered by attending physicians for inpatients from medical floors in the hospital
- •Follow patients who require continued intervention throughout hospitalization

•Diabetes, Gastroenterology, Sickle Cell, Headache, Late Effects, Rare Chromosome Disorders, Neuro-genetics, Neuro-muscular

Neuropsychological Evaluations

- Outpatient evaluations: full neuropsychological batteries for CNS conditions
- Inpatient evaluations: pre-/post-surgical evaluations for epilepsy and oncology

- Respond to consultations ordered by attending physicians to inpatients from medical floors in the hospital
- Follow patients who require continued intervention throughout hospitalization

• Epilepsy, Neuro-Oncology, Neuro-Cardiac


Teaching
