


Modules and Live Session Enrollment CME




Type the link into your web browser <u>cernerCME.baptisthealth.net</u>


- If you already have an account click Log In.
- If you do not have an account on the CME portal, click **Create New Account** and continue with the steps to create a new account.




Once you've logged in, click Cerner Courses.




Next, click the Medical Informatics (CERNER) course.




Click Enroll, then select the online training that corresponds with your specialty.



This will take you to the course description page, Click Register.




Select the **Start Course** button to begin.
