

Remote Access setup for New users

First step is to ensure you have Citrix installed on your computer. If you do not have it, follow the simple steps below.





For Windows computer simply open the Microsoft Store, search for Citrix Workspace, install the app and reboot the computer.



For Mac computers, Google search "Citrix Workspace for Mac", open the website, download file, install and reboot the computer

After installing Citrix, you must reboot your computer to continue.

Setup Authenticator App

The first step is to download the Microsoft Authenticator application onto your mobile device. **NOTE**: if you have the Microsoft Authenticator App on your mobile device, skip to step 5
