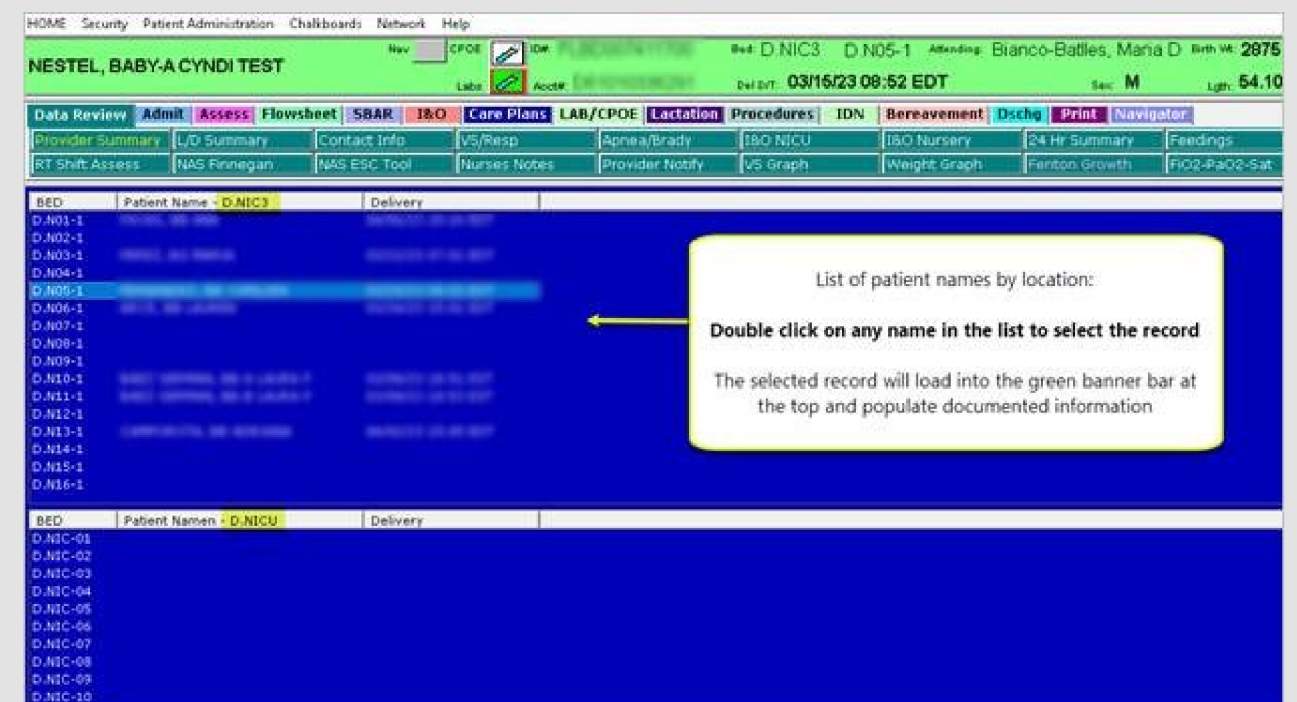

CPN WAN 2 - University



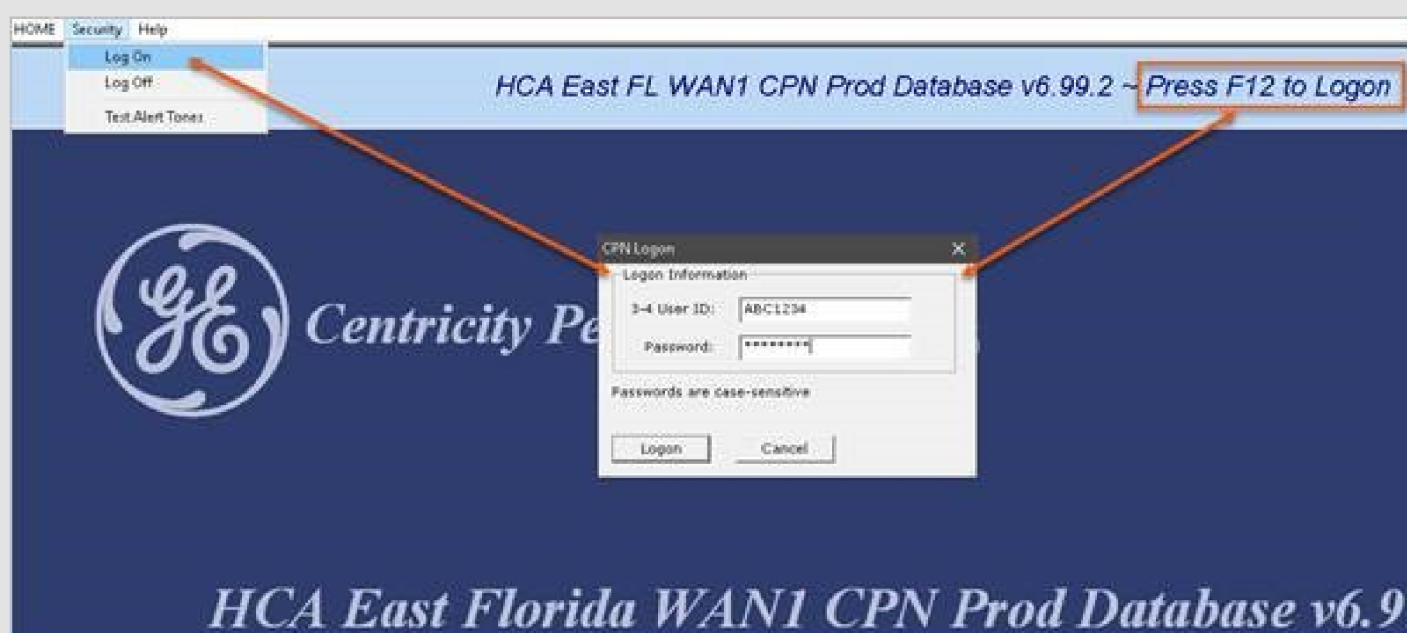

Once you have selected the facility - you can find the patient by location and double-click on the patient name to see the record.



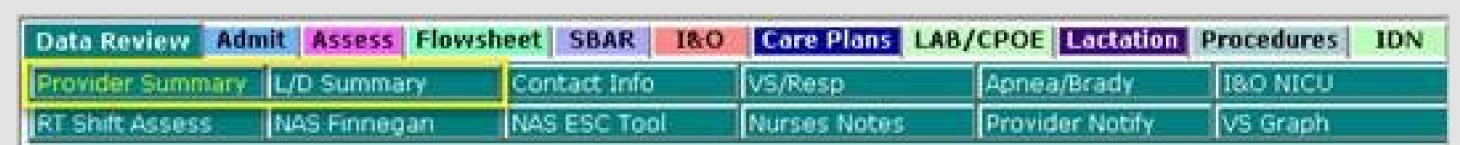

To login to CPN you can press F12 on the keyboard or find Security in the upper left of the screen and from the dropdown menu select Log On.
Then enter your HCA 3-4ID and password.



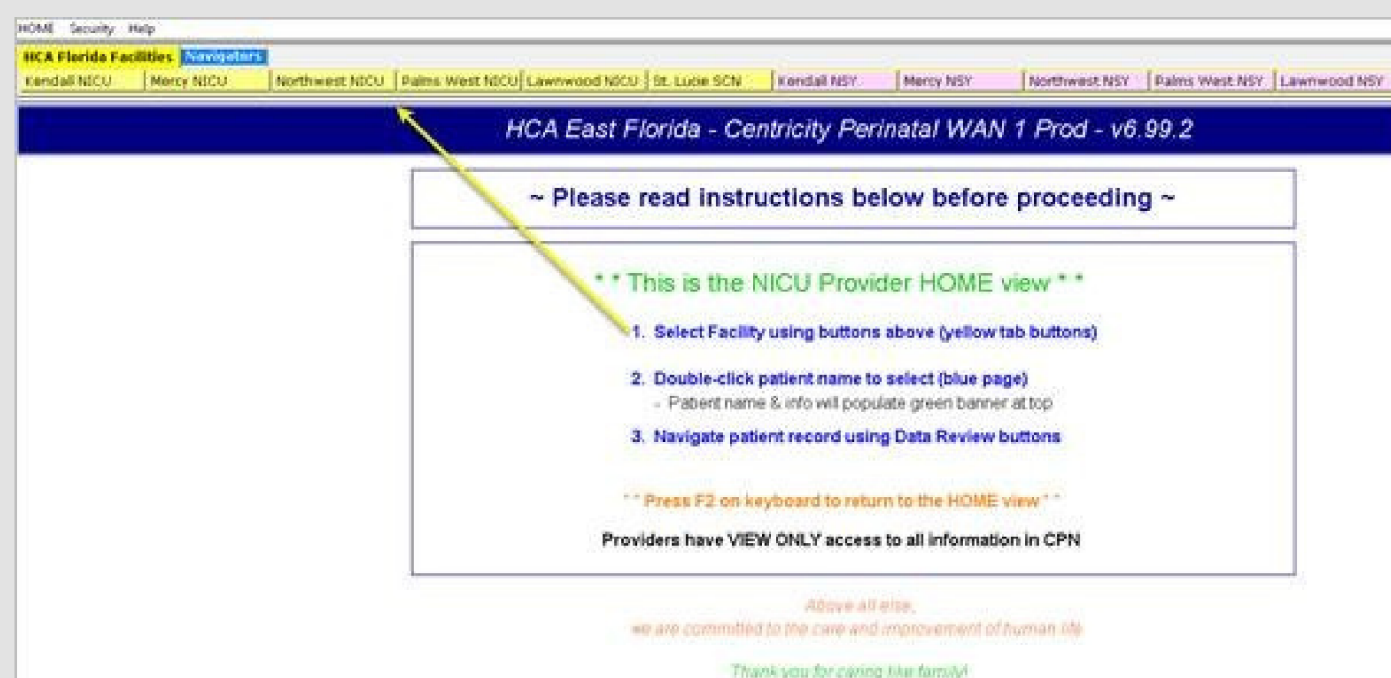

You can easily navigate the data using the Tab and Chart buttons at the top to review nursing documentation. On the Data Review tab, the Provider Summary and L/D Summary show the maternal health history, pregnancy conditions and delivery information.



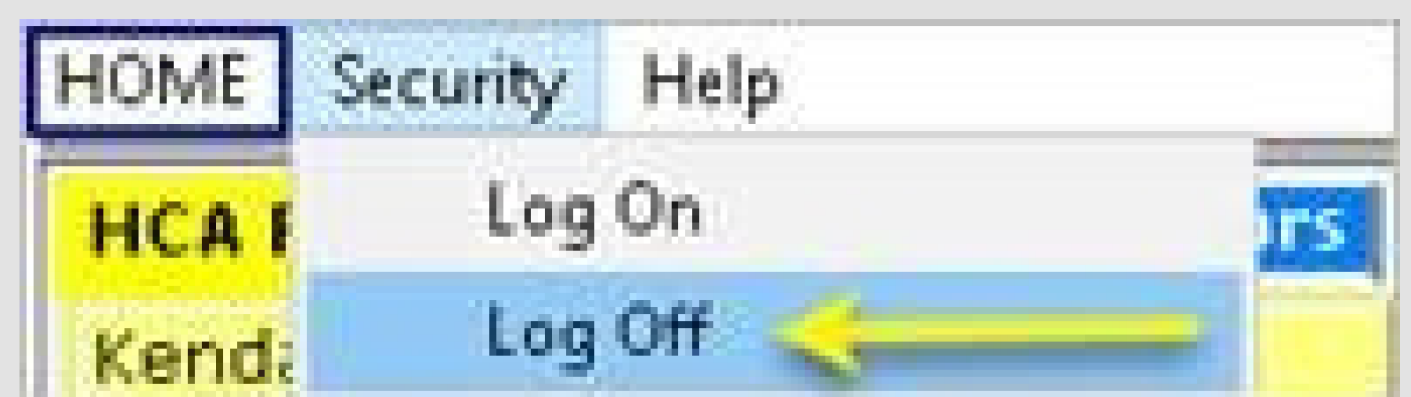

Once in CPN, you will see the Neonatal provider view home page with options for multiple facilities. Select the appropriate facility to begin. Some actions, such as 'select patient,' may return you to the home page.

If you need to return to the home screen to select another patient or start over, press F2 on the keyboard or click Home in the upper left corner. When finished, press F12 or go to Security then select Logoff.
