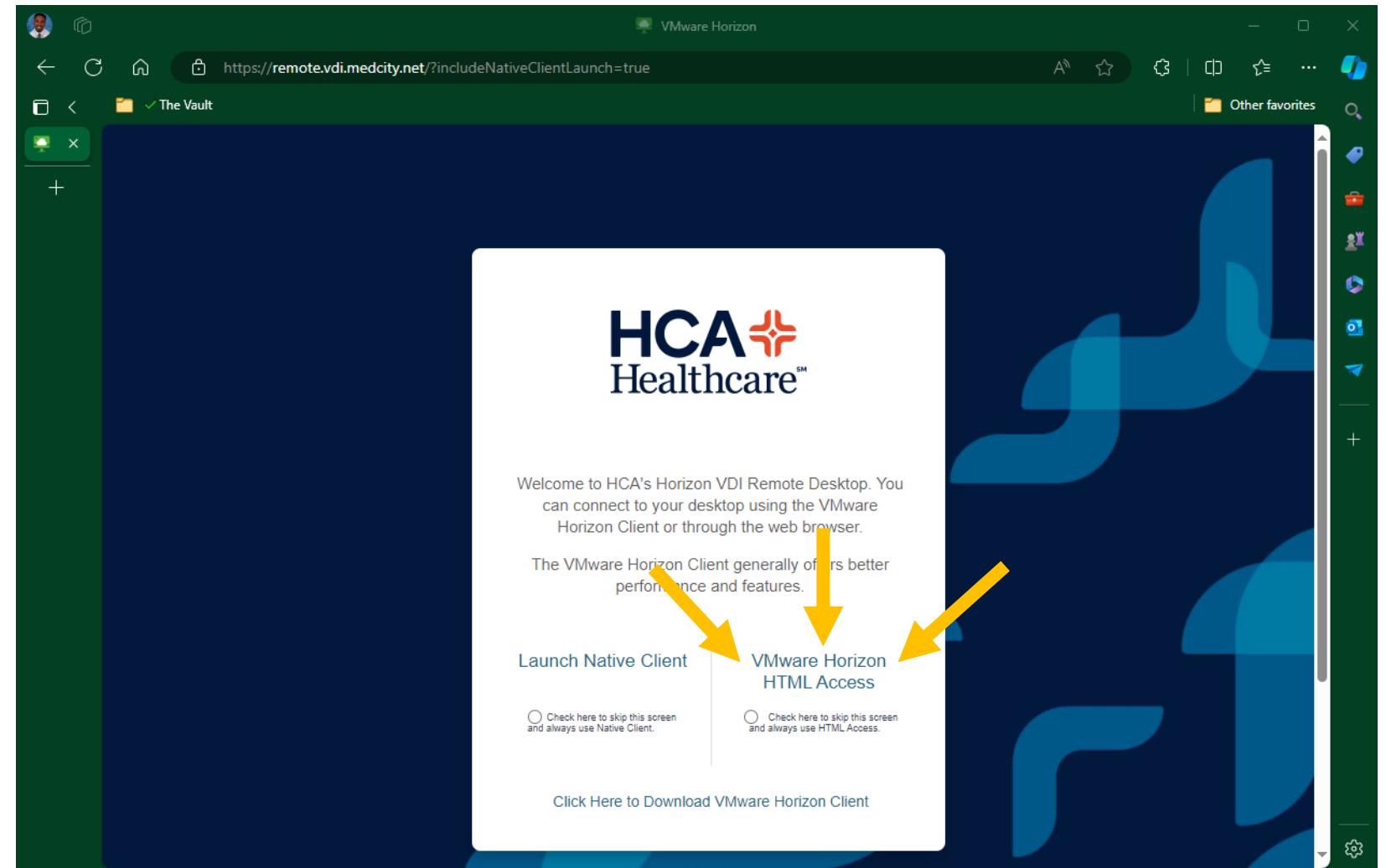

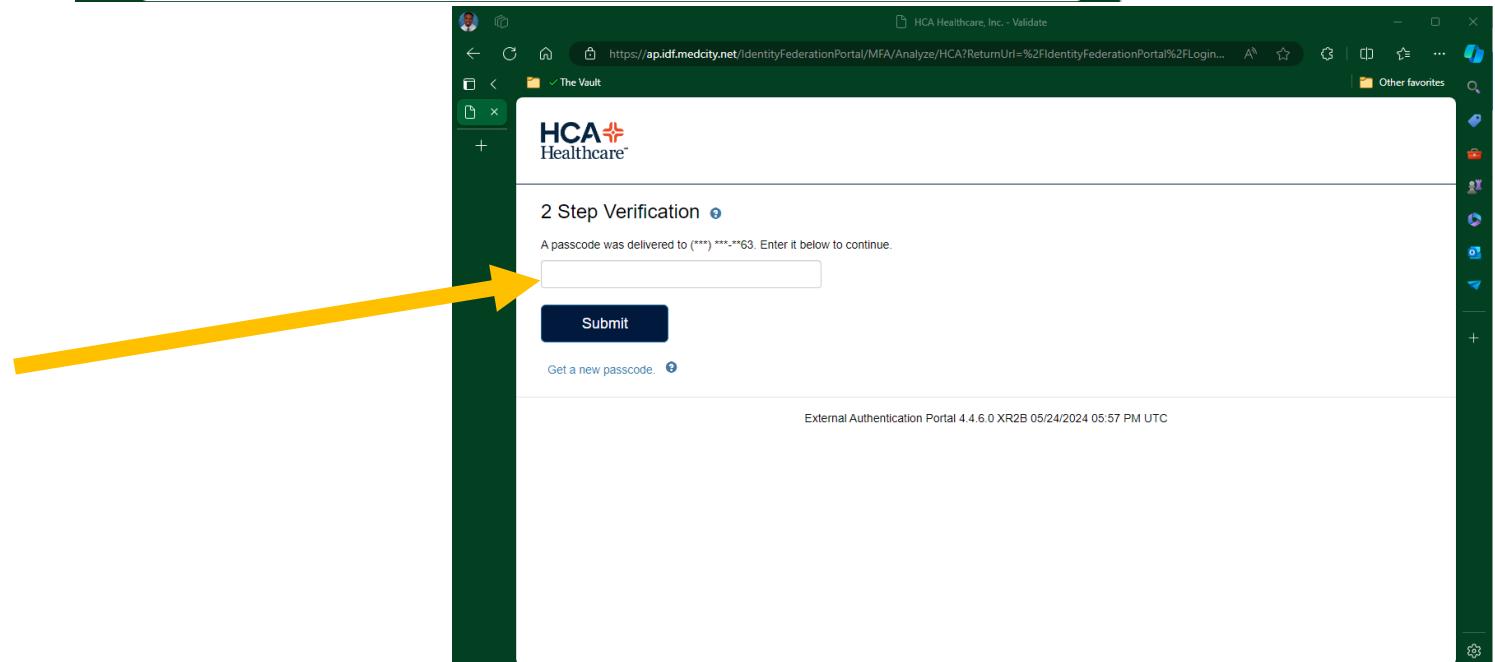
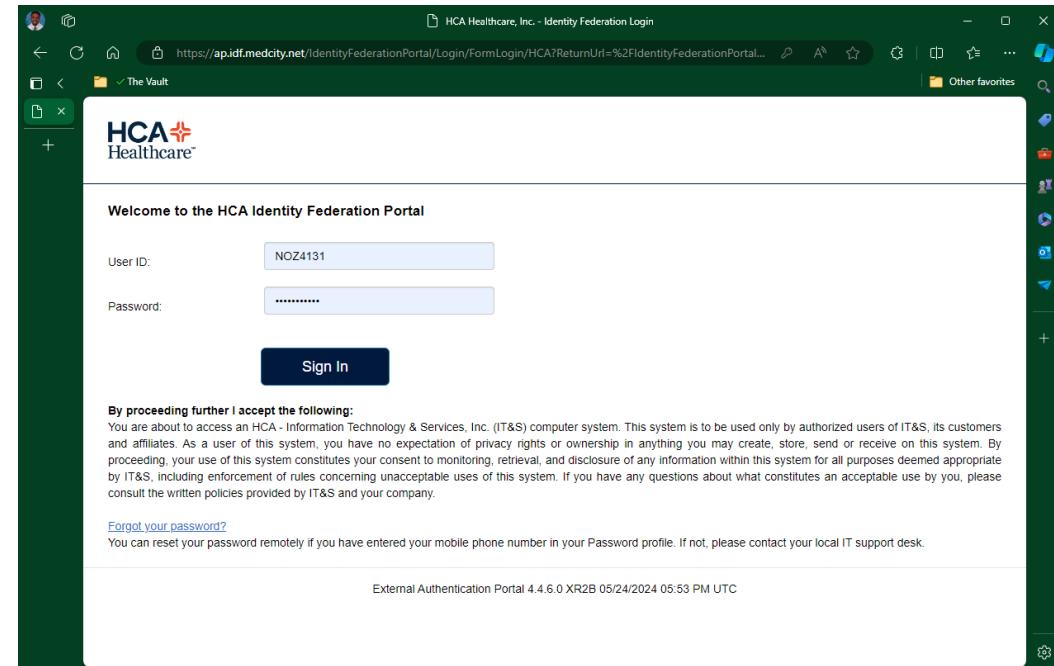
Login

- Use any browser to go to [VMware Horizon \(medcity.net\)](https://remote.vdi.medcity.net/?includeNativeClientLaunch=true)
- Choose the option to the right entitled, **‘Vmware Horizon HTML Access’**
 - This allow you to use the web-based version of the EMR



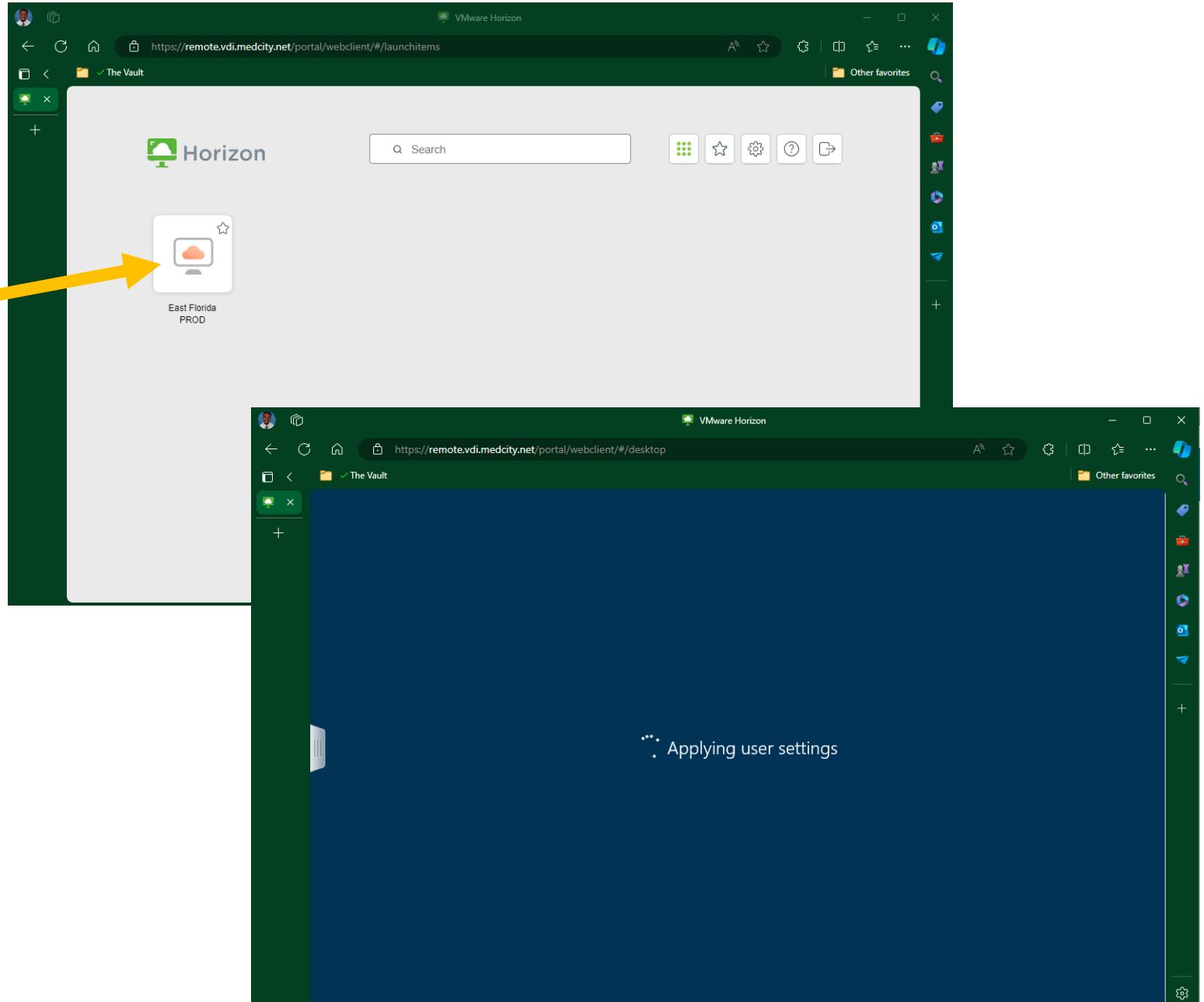
Login

 - Ex: User: NOZ4131



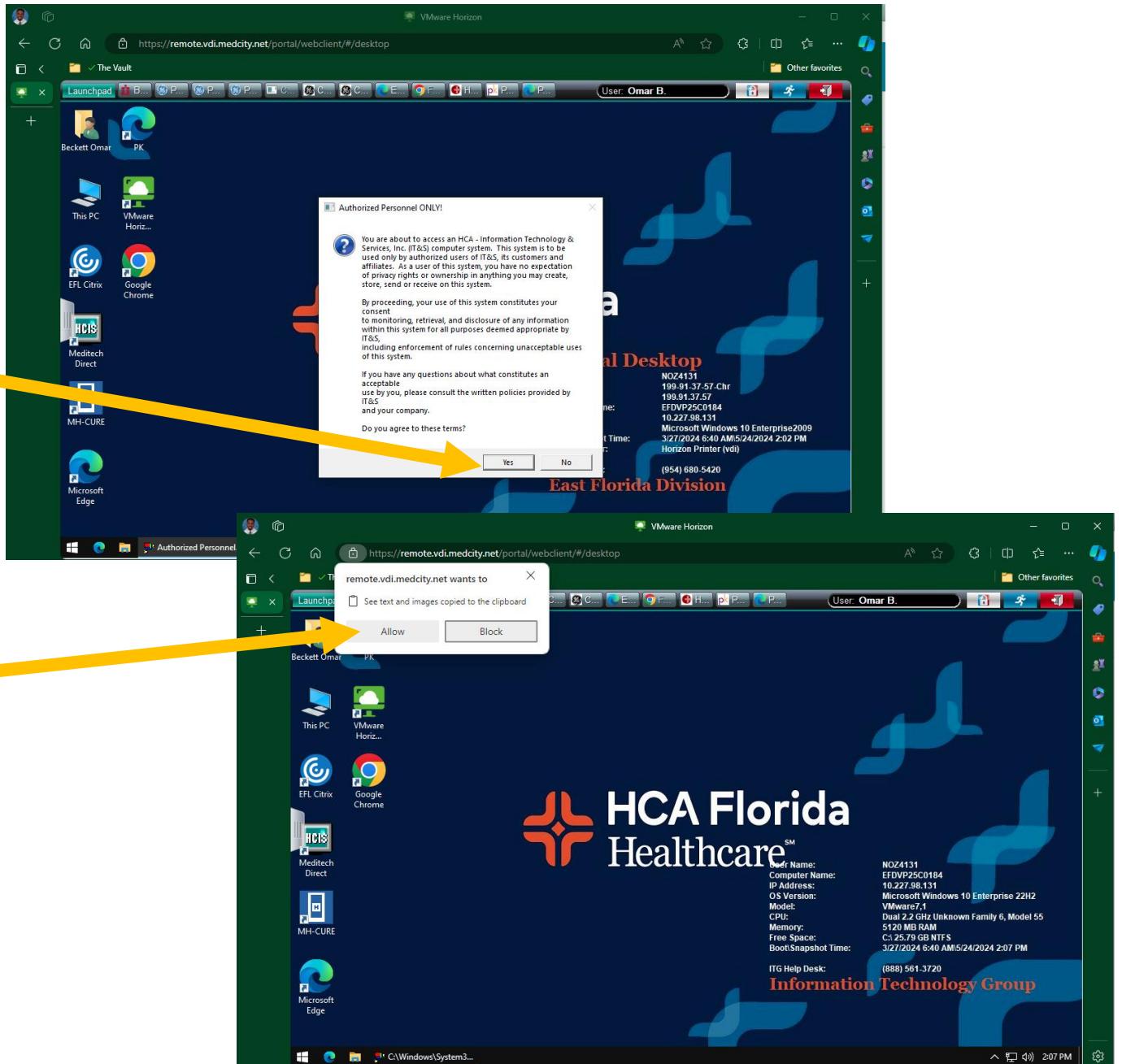
Login

- This should start to setup your virtual desktop on the HCA network



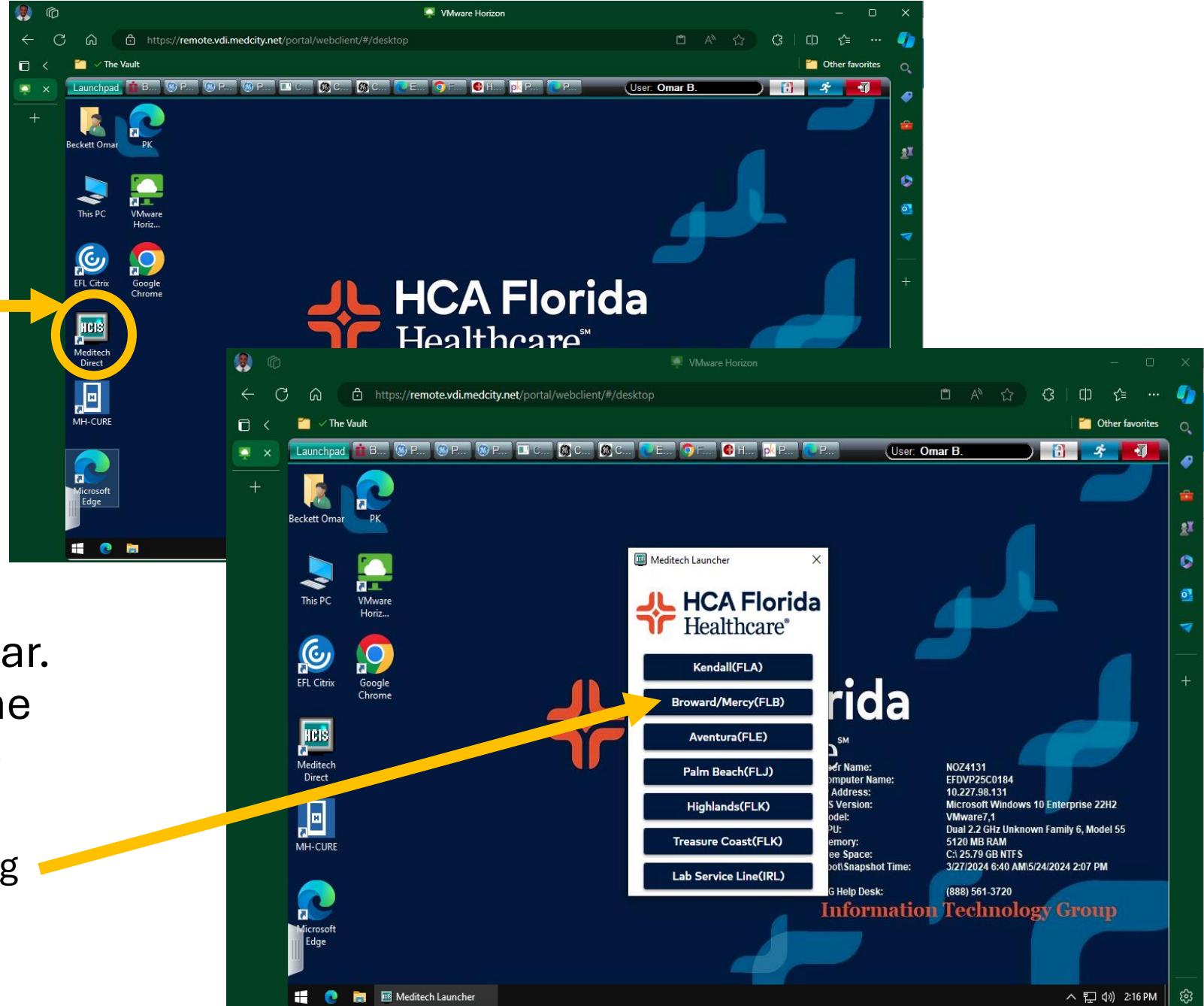
Login

- There may be a pop-up in a corner of your screen that will give you the ability to **'copy and paste'** text from the computer you are using into their system, click **'Allow'**



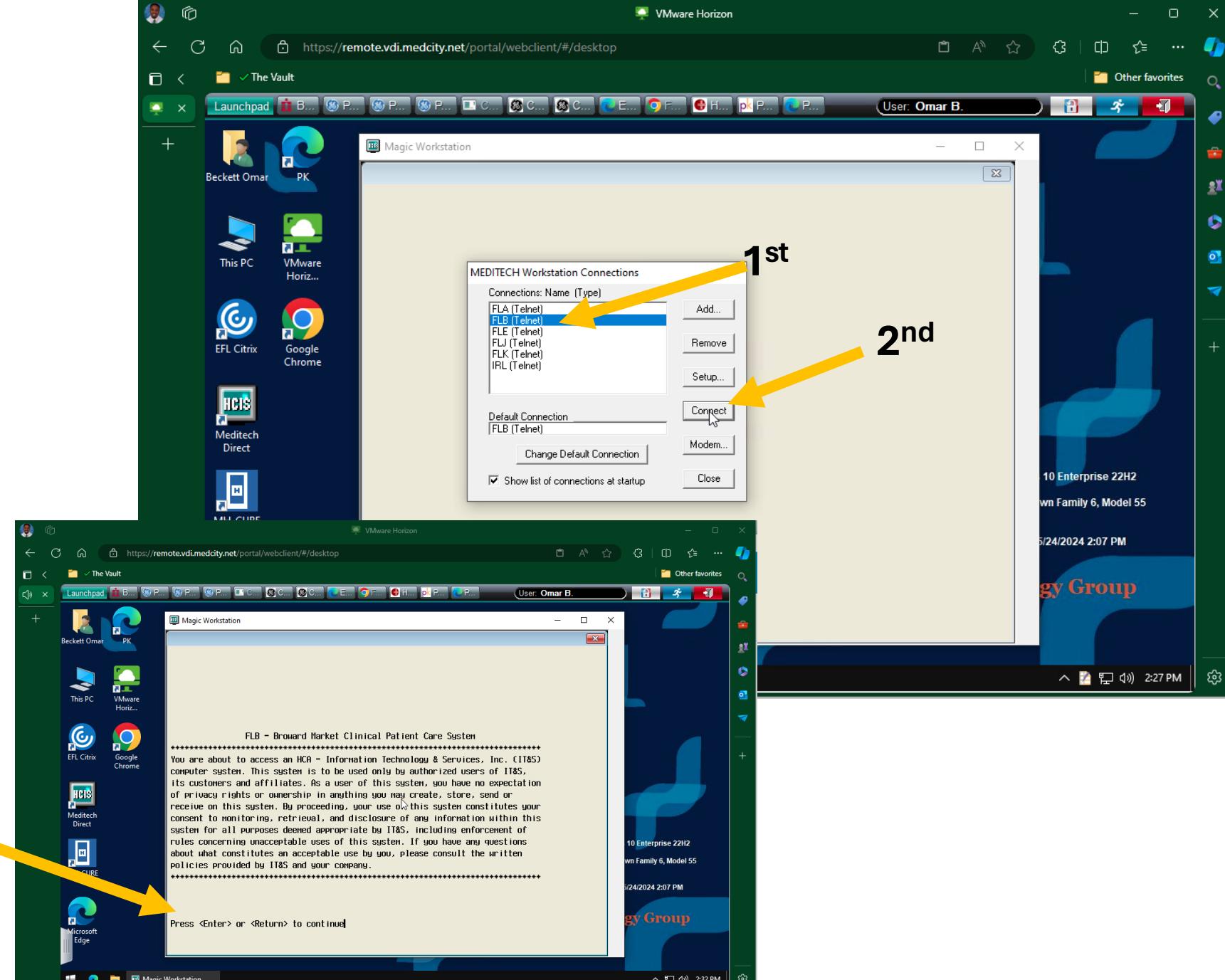
Login

- Double-Click on the **'Meditech Direct'** icon to access the EMR



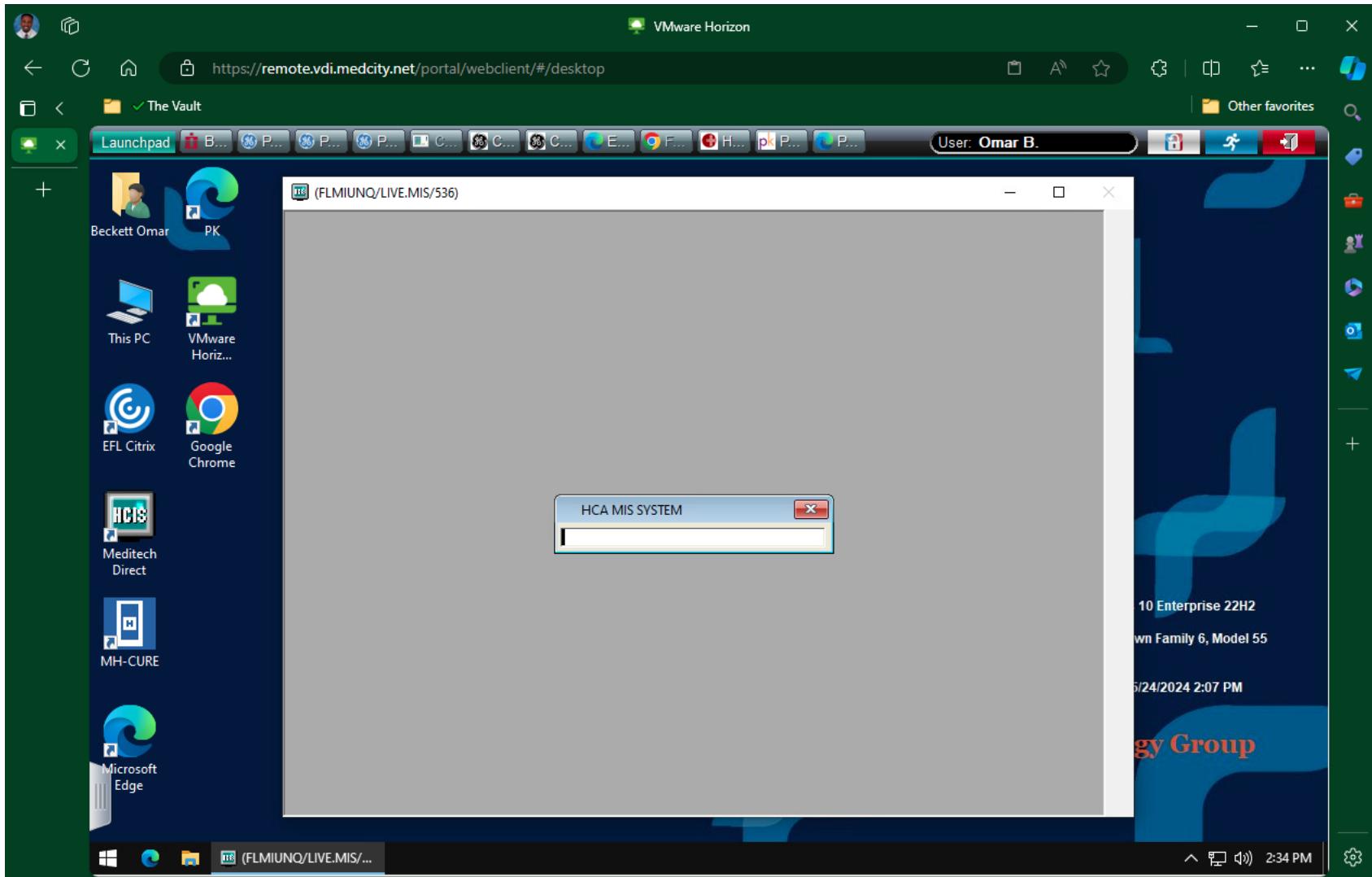
Login

- Hit '**Enter**' or '**Return**' on your keyboard at this screen



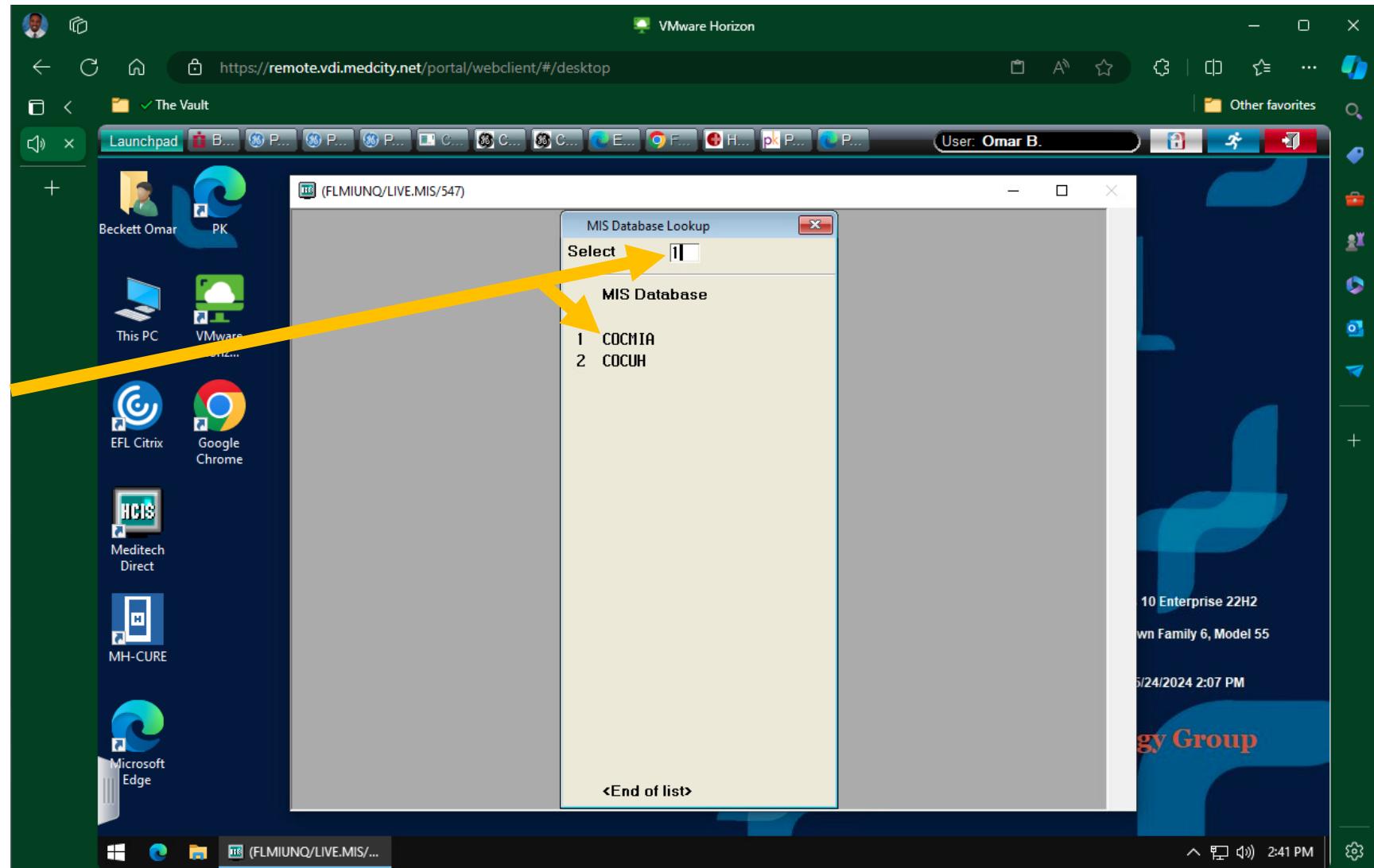
Login

- At this screen, I was told my Tech Support to hit the **‘F9 button’** on your keyboard



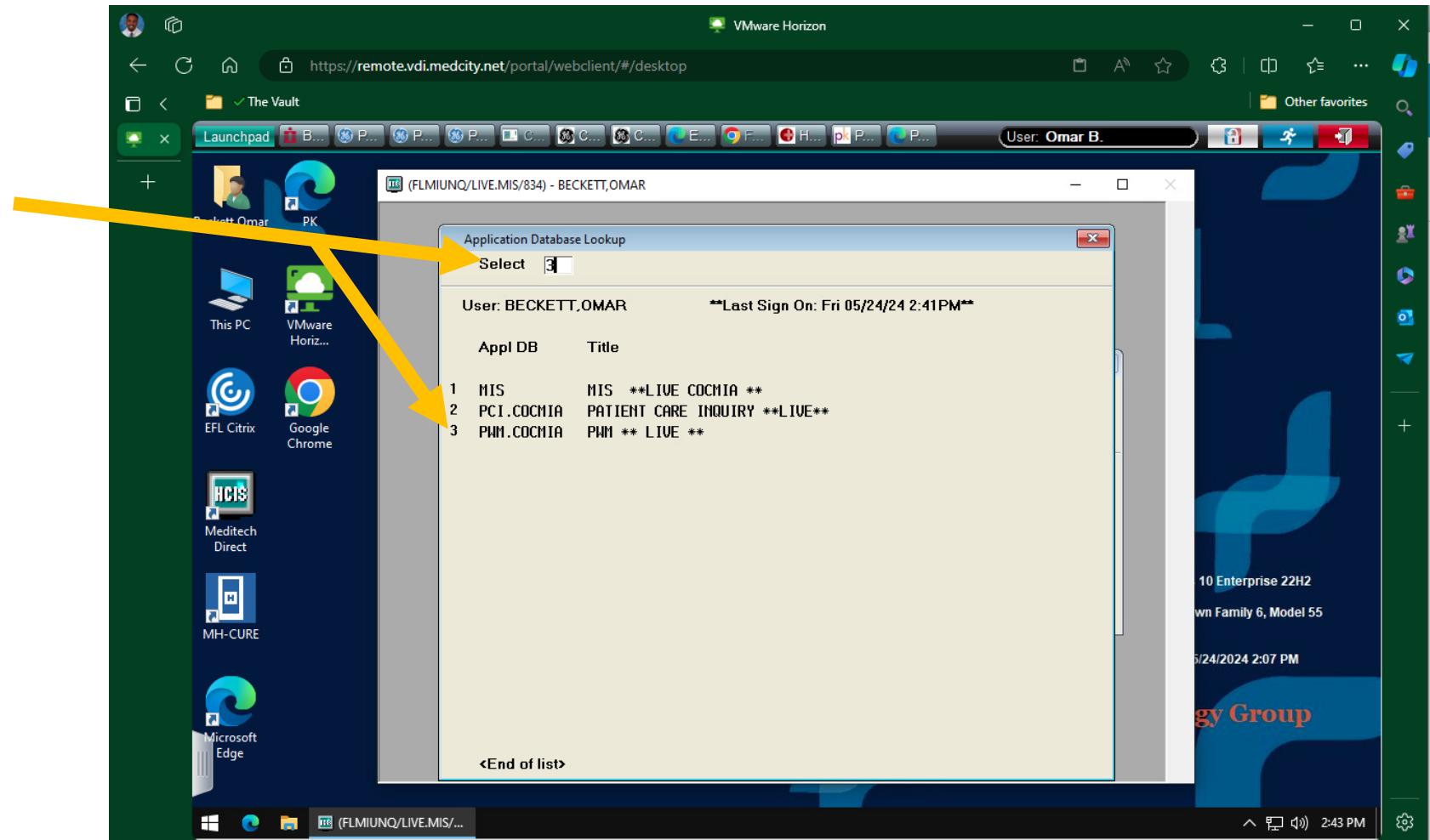
EMR

- This screen will pop-up and you will type and select option ‘1’ ‘COCMIA’



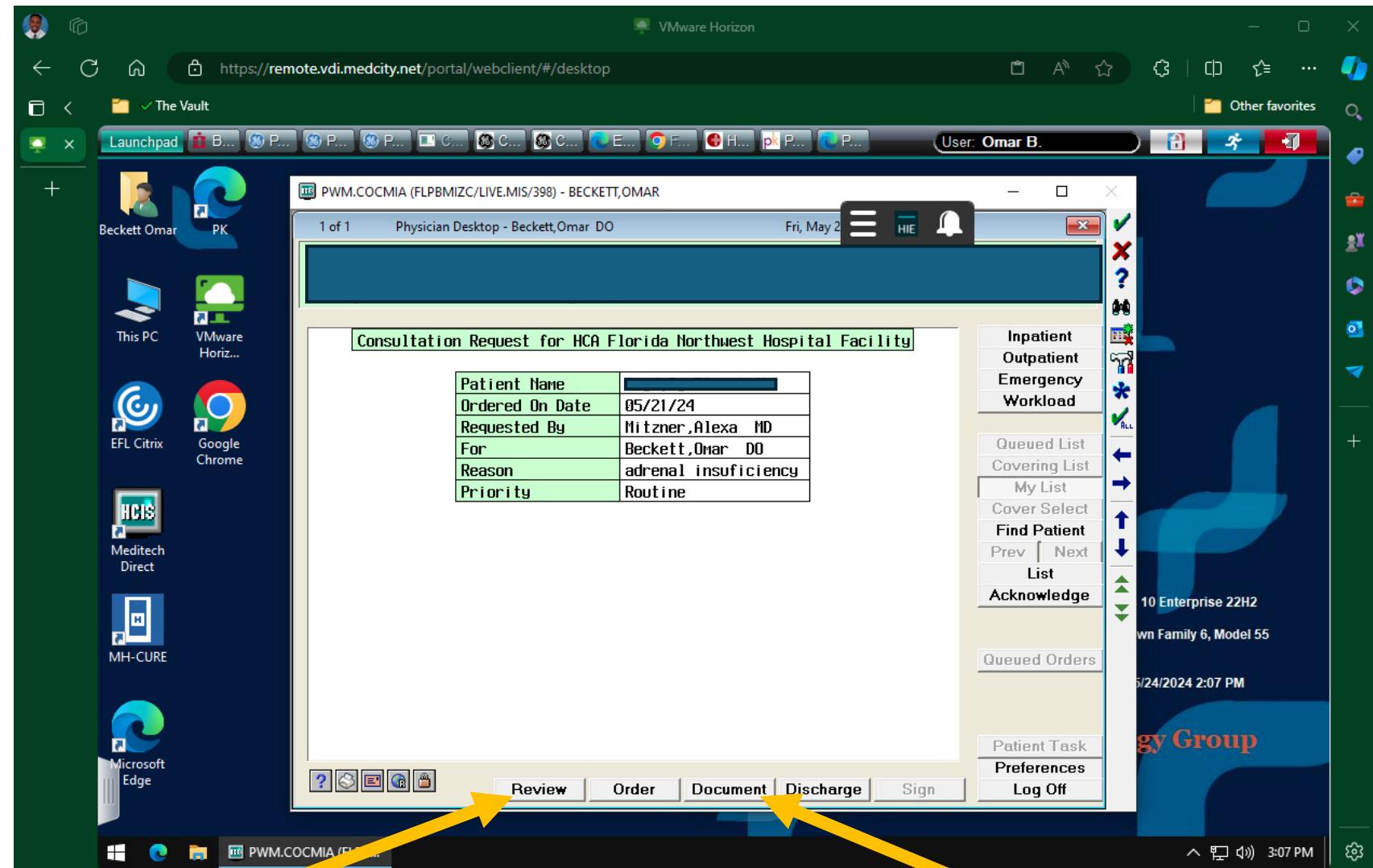
EMR

- Once you select a patient, you will be able to;

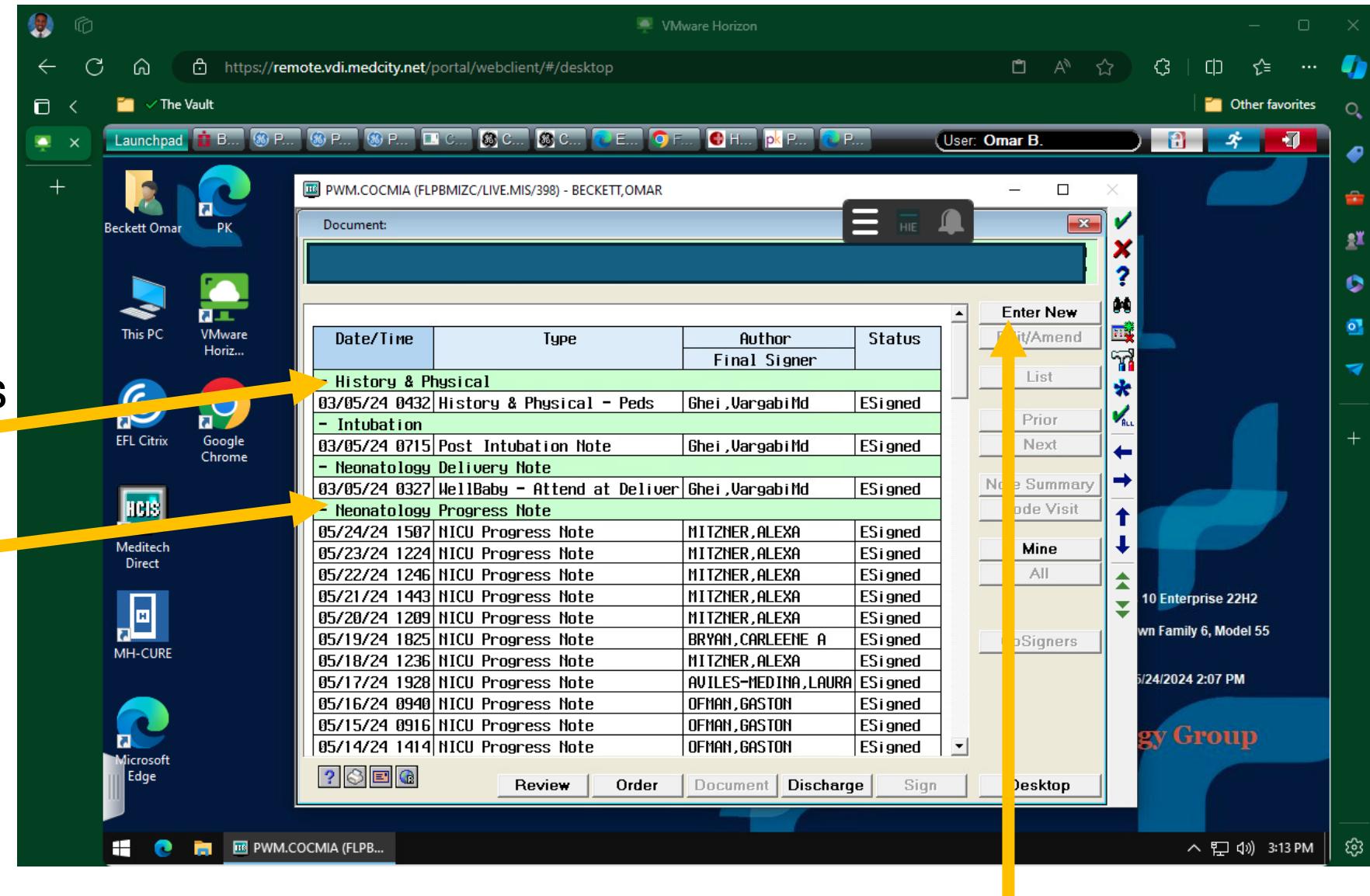


1. 'Review' – Labs & Notes
