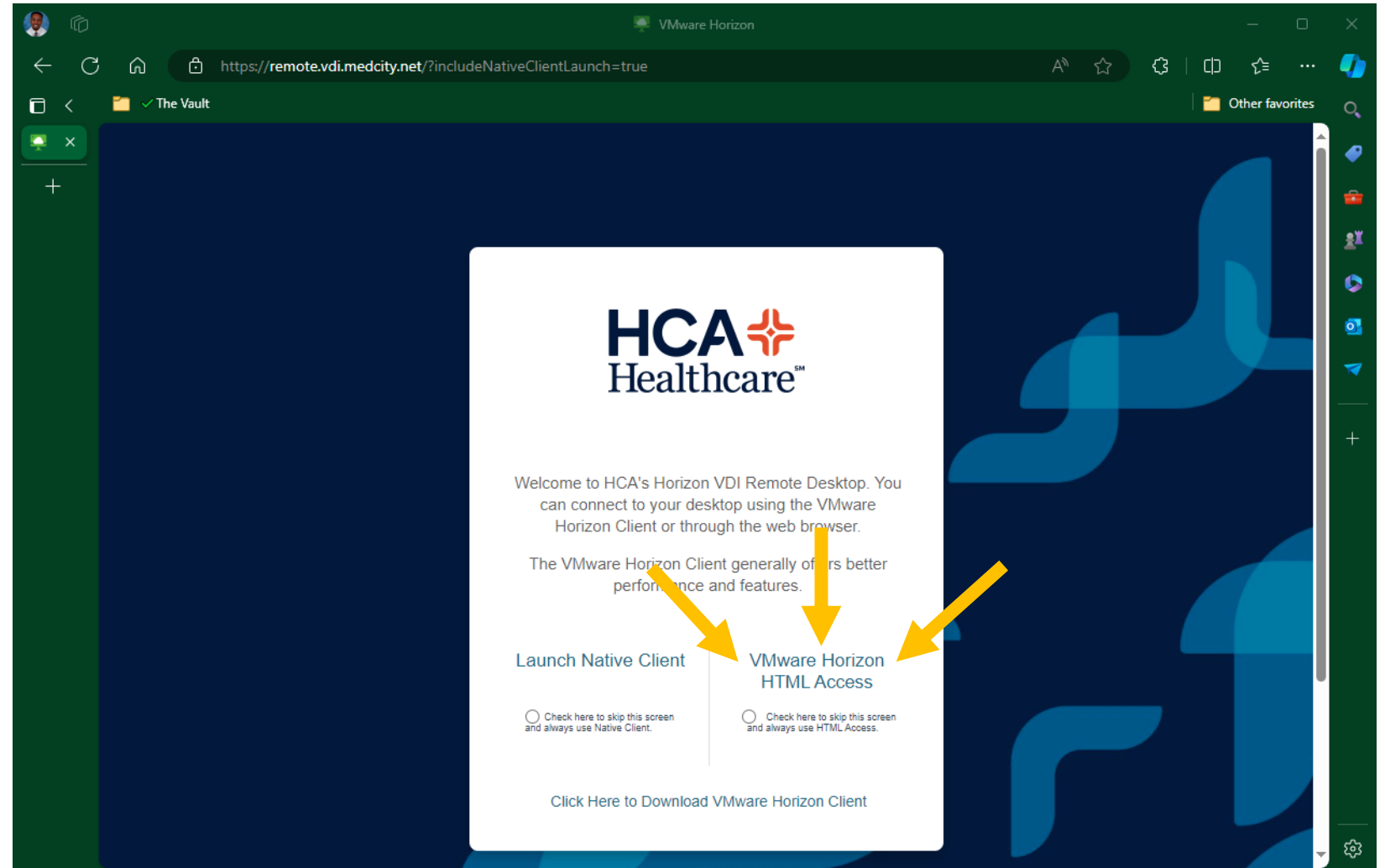

# Login


- Use any browser to go to [VMware Horizon \(medcity.net\)](https://remote.vdi.medcity.net)


- Use your Login information that was initially assigned to you by HCA

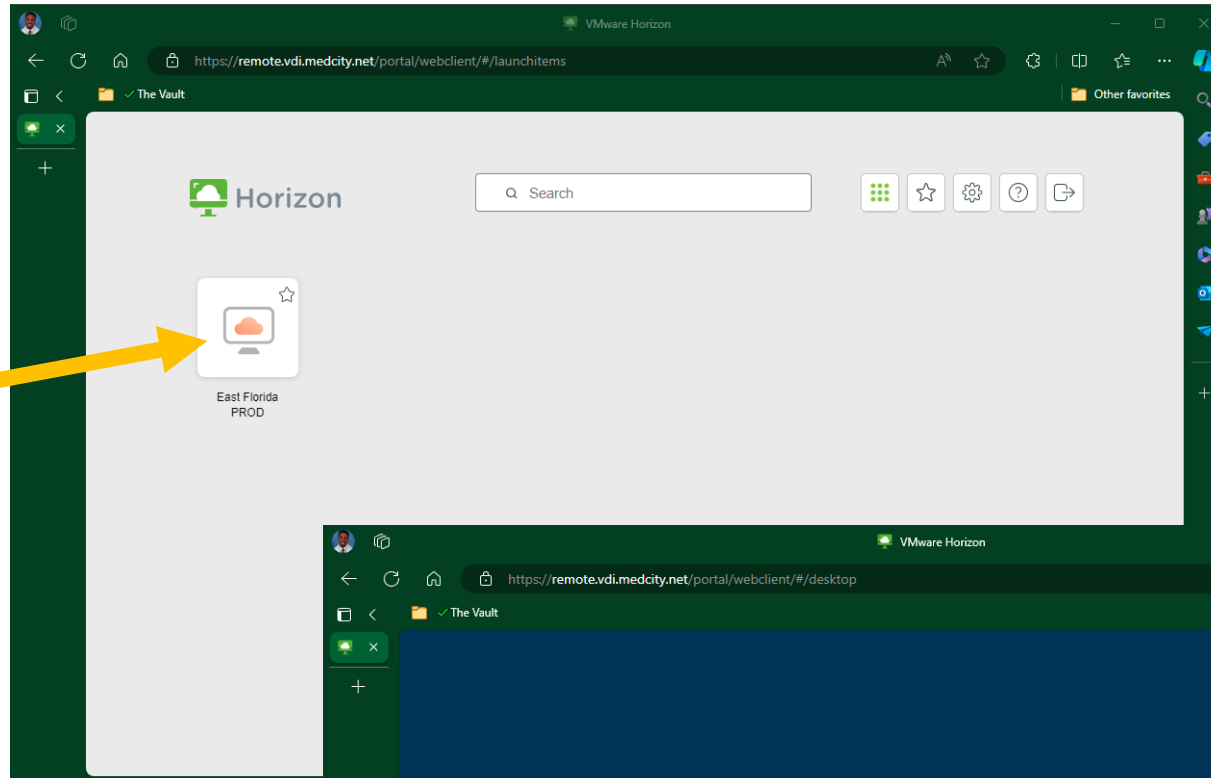

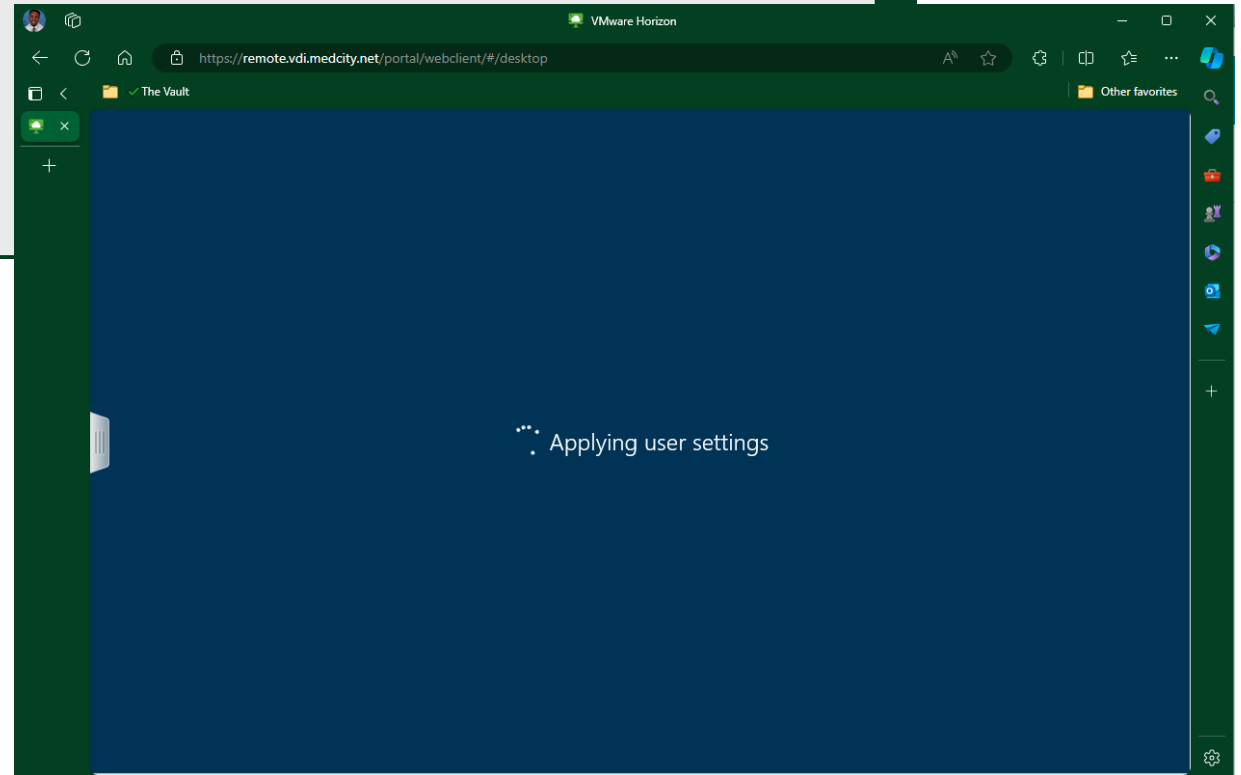

- Select the only option '**East Florida PROD**'

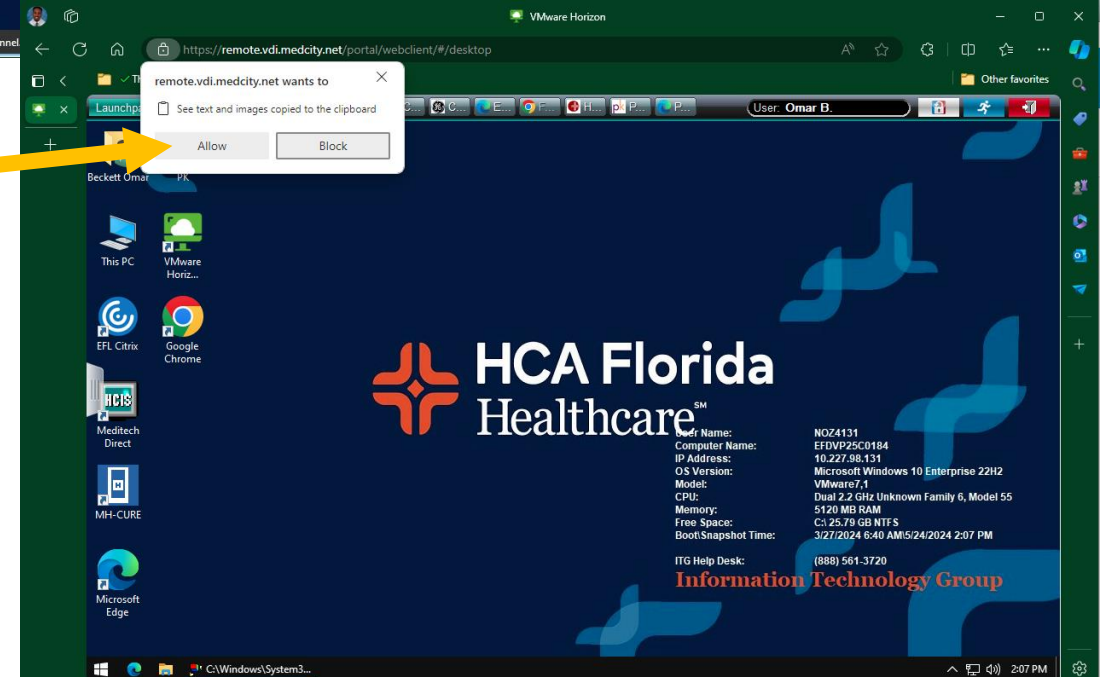
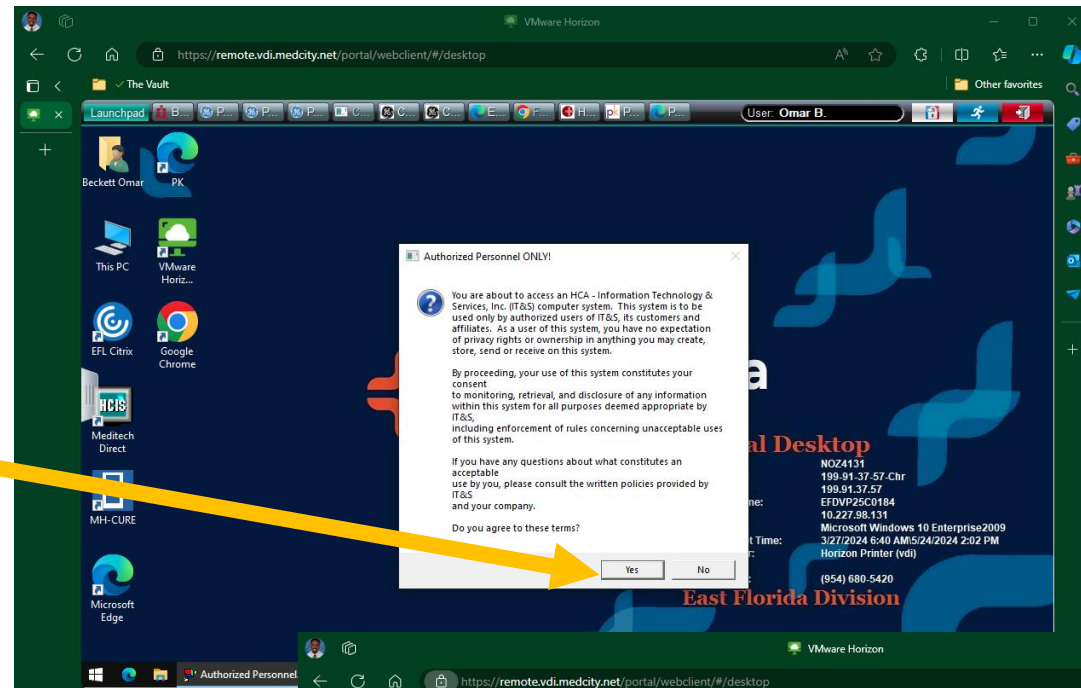


- This should start to setup your virtual desktop on the HCA network



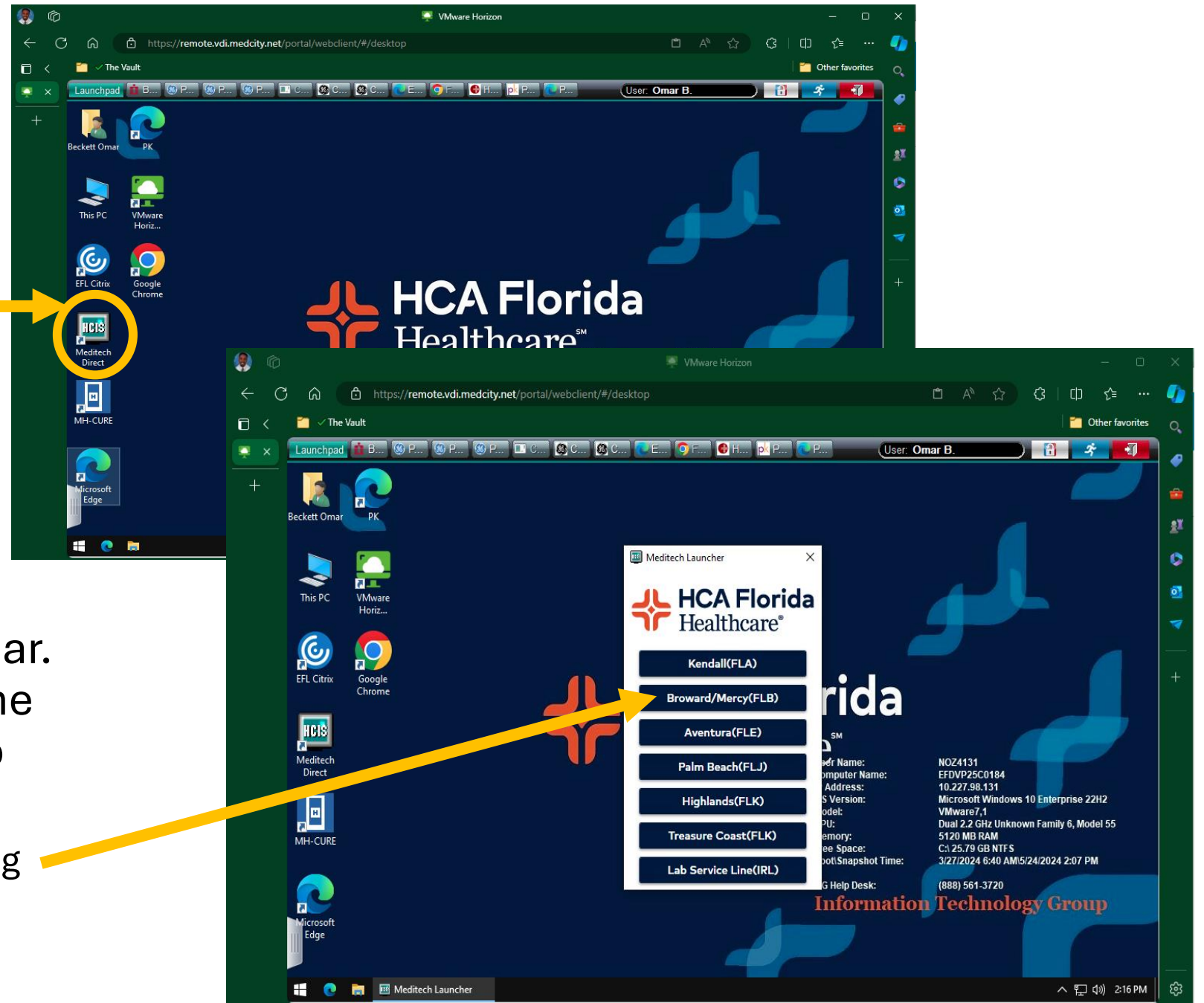
# Login

- There may be a pop-up in a corner of your screen that will give you the ability to 'copy and paste' text from the computer you are using into their system, click '**Allow**'



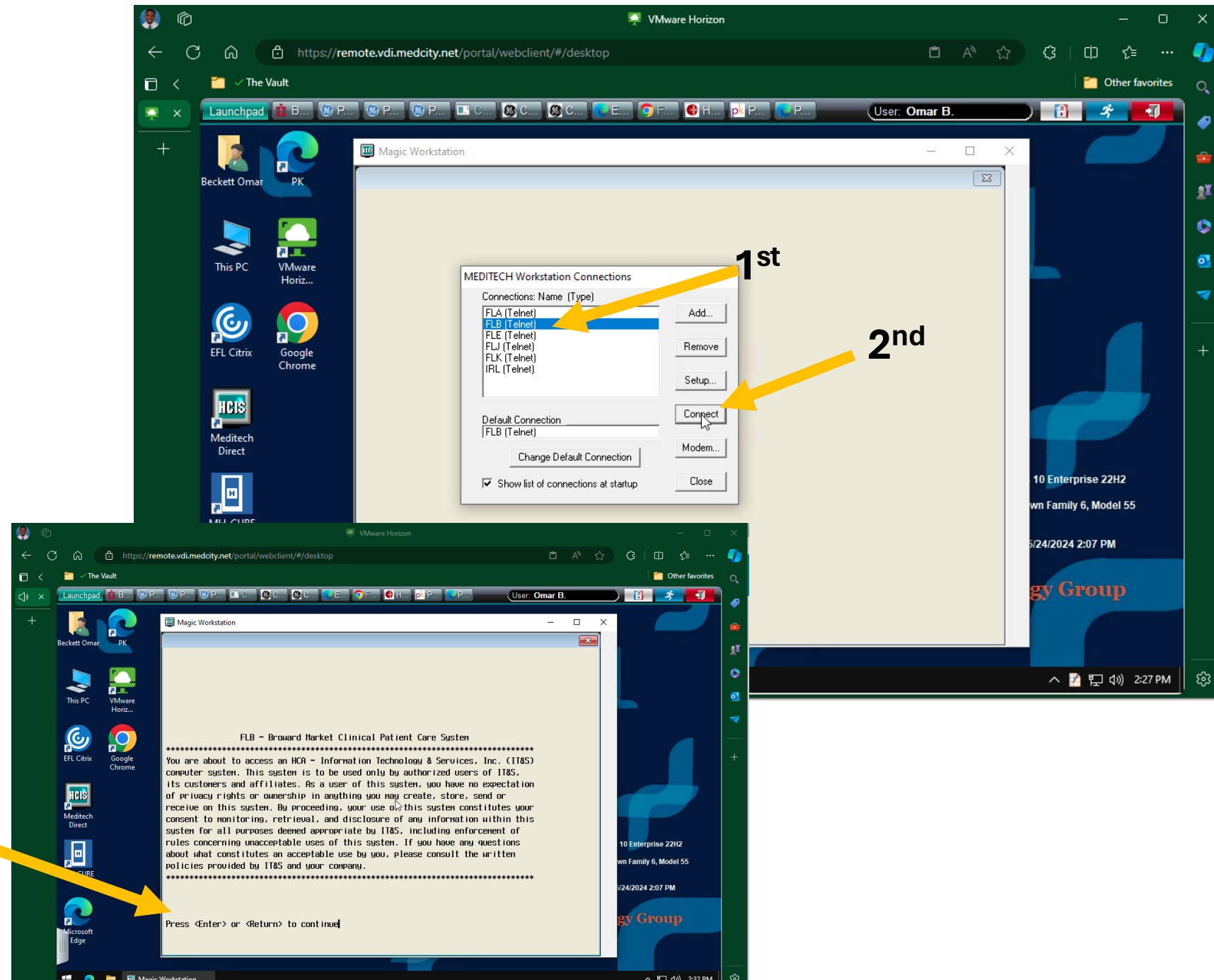
# Login

# Login

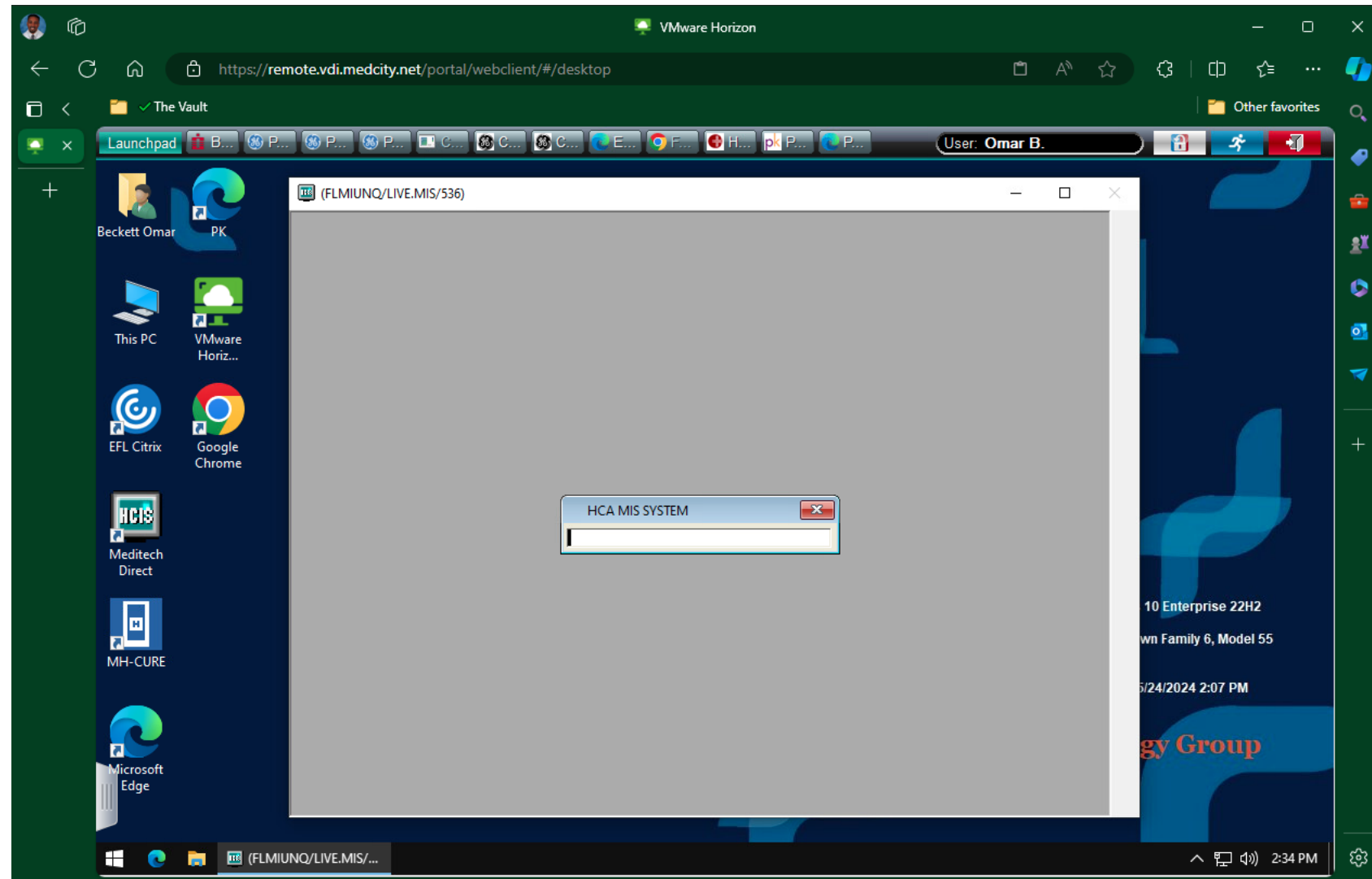
- Confirm the Connection by first selecting '**FLB (Telnet)**' and then clicking '**Connect**'

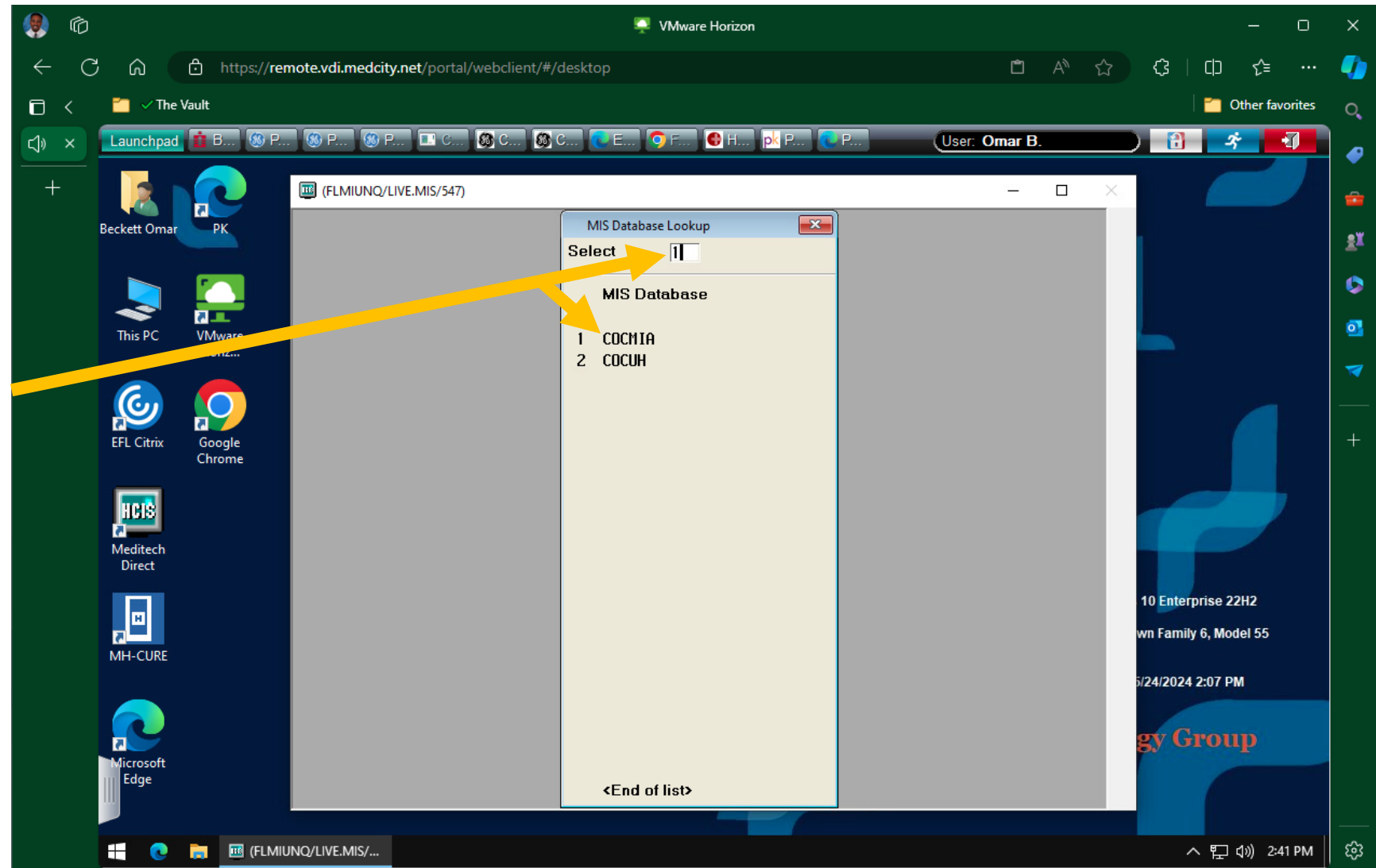
- At this screen, I was told my Tech Support to hit the **'F9 button'** on your keyboard





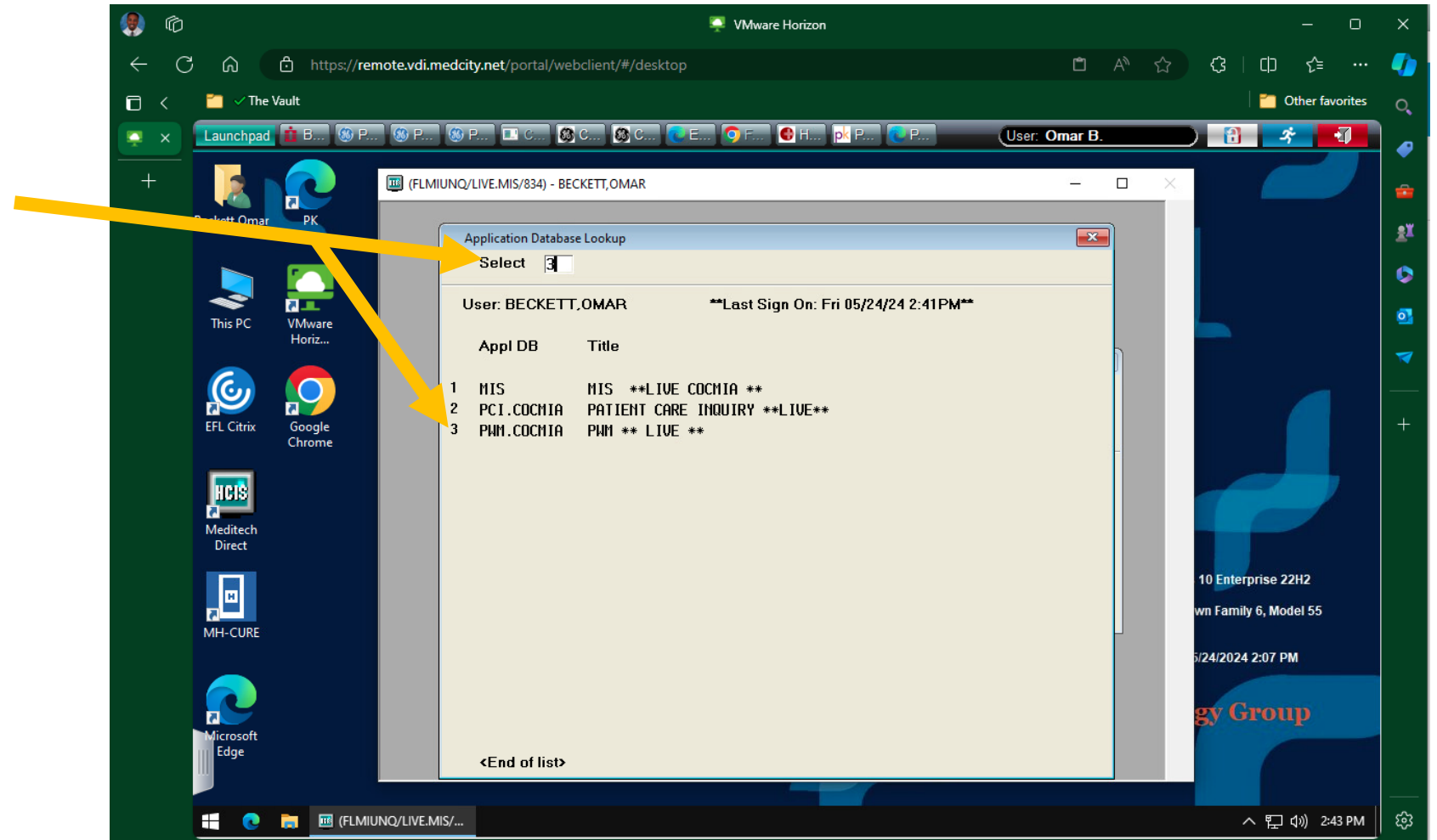
# EMR

- This screen will pop-up and you will type and select option '1' 'COCMIA'



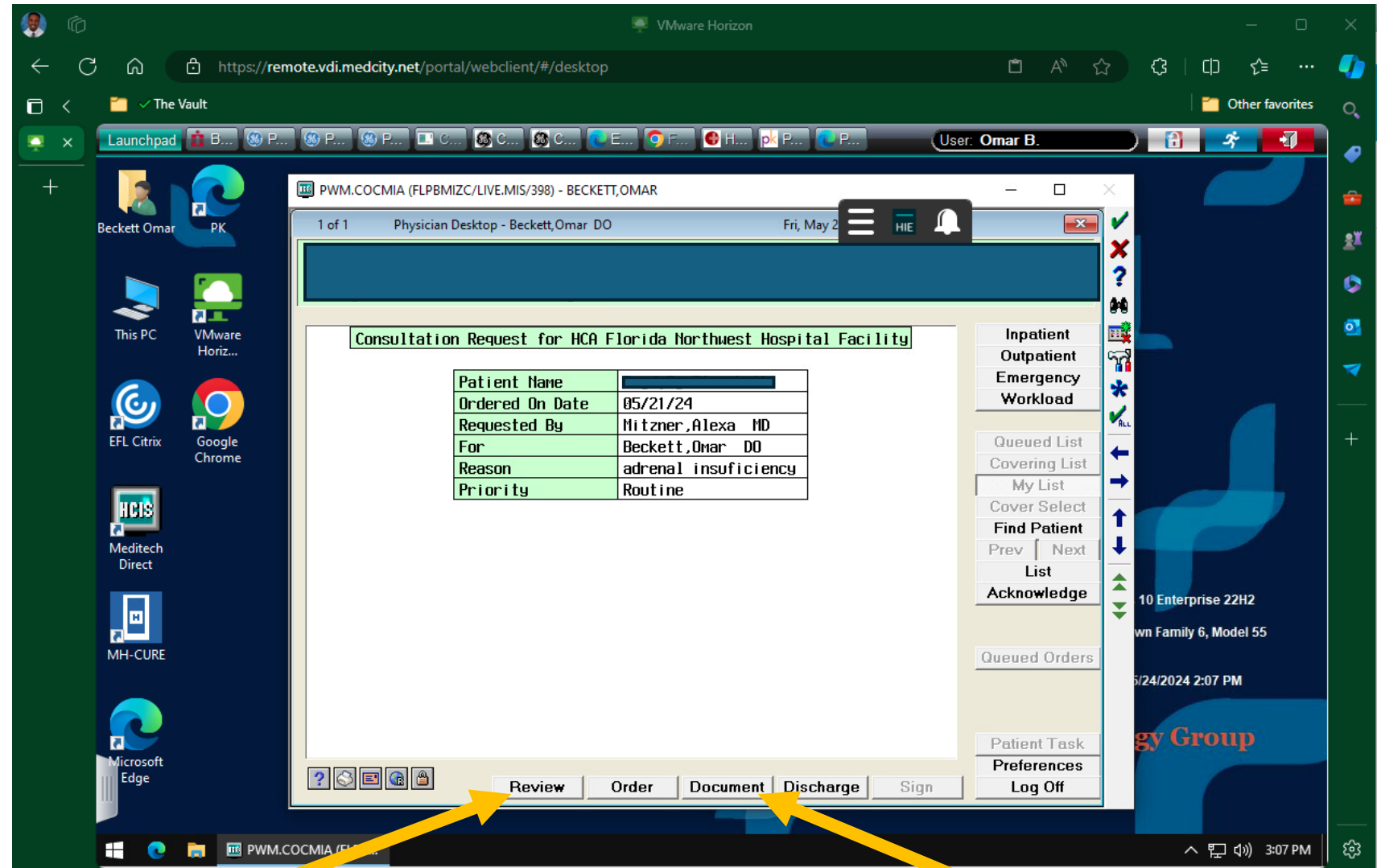
# EMR
